

Site mobilisation and initial works at Victoria Park

Victoria Park is the future home of the new Brisbane Stadium and National Aquatic Centre.

These venues will bring long-lasting benefits to Queenslanders, far beyond their starring role in the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Site mobilisation and initial works

From Monday 1 June 2026 GIICA will commence site establishment activities on the Herston side of Victoria Park. This includes installing temporary fencing, changes to traffic and transport conditions, survey work and repurposing existing buildings into site facilities and offices.

What to expect

The following activities will occur from 1 June 2026:

- Installation of fencing around part of the Herston side of Victoria Park including closing access from the Herston and QUT/Kelvin Grove busway stations (see map overleaf)
- Gilchrist Avenue will be closed to public vehicles including all parking. Construction access only
- Minor relocation of Northern Brisbane Bikeway (shared pathway) to Gilchrist Avenue
- Traffic control, line marking and signage installed to assist motorists and active transport users
- Heavy vehicle movements for the delivery of plant and materials via Gilchrist Avenue

- Site and ground investigations, services identification, historical and cultural heritage surveying
- Vegetation trimming may be required
- Repurposing buildings to fit out as site offices
- Removal of redundant infrastructure
- Lighting for night work.

Work hours

All construction activities will occur during standard works hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

As part of site mobilisation, including fencing installation, some night works will occur from 6:30pm to 6:30am Monday to Saturday.

All work is subject to relevant approvals, construction conditions and weather.

GIICA is committed to minimising the impact of construction activities and noise on the surrounding community as far as possible.

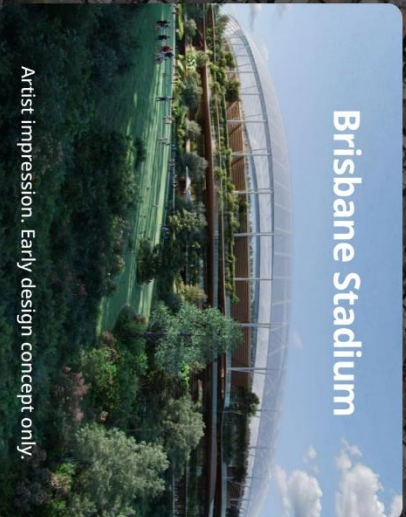
