Logan Indoor Sports Centre, Democracy Way, Logan Central

May 2026

The Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority (GIICA) is laying the foundations for the world's biggest event in 2032.

We are responsible for delivering the 17 new and upgraded venues across Queensland jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland Governments ahead of the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The new Logan Indoor Sports Centre will deliver a nine-court venue across two halls, bringing the Games to Logan and creating a legacy for community sporting participation long beyond 2032.

Forming the centrepiece of the Logan Central Civic and Community Precinct, the new indoor sports centre will provide multi-purpose courts capable of hosting a variety of indoor sports and community events.

Site investigations

Site investigations are needed to better understand ground conditions at the site of the Logan Indoor Sports Centre.

These investigations will include bore hole drilling, excavation of shallow test pits and soil sampling to provide insights into sediment and ground conditions to guide design.

What to expect

Site investigations are expected to commence from early June and may continue for a few weeks on the site on Democracy Way.

Most works will take place within the footprint of buildings demolished earlier this year and the existing car park.

The works and activity will include:

- Installation of additional fencing around work locations, beyond the demolition footprint
- Truck based bore hole drilling
- Soil testing
- Digging test pits
- Ground and cultural survey activities
- Signage installed to assist motorists and active transport users navigate temporary impacts
- Temporary reduction of car park spaces off Democracy Way
- Some additional heavy vehicle movements on Democracy Way and Jacaranda Avenue.

Work hours

Construction activities will be undertaken within standard works hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Friday. Additional notification will be provided ahead of any work outside these hours including weekend or night work.

All work is subject to relevant approvals, weather and construction conditions.

GIICA is committed to minimising the impact of construction activities and noise on the surrounding community as far as possible.
